

## **Official clarification note #4**

**Reference No. ITB#KYR 02/2016**

**“Construction of Rocket and Artillery Weapons (RAW) Depot in Military Unit 30630 in Buzhum Village Kara-Bulak a/o of Batken district, Construction of Rocket and Artillery Weapons (RAW) Depot and Refurbishment of existent Storage for Small Arms and Light Weapons and Conventional Ammunition (SALW and CA) and fence installation around storage in the military unit № 92843, Gul’cha village, Osh oblast, Kyrgyz Republic”.**

A potential bidder asked the following questions to which OSCE Center in Bishkek provided the below clarifications:

### **Question No.1**

Can a company with the average annual volume of construction work less than 500,000 EUR for the previous 3 years submit a bid for lot 1?

### **Answer No.1**

According to the tender dossier a potential bidder must meet this requirement. This threshold is established to allow only companies who have sufficient financial capacity to implement the contract in case of its award.

If bidder does not have the required level of volume, but can demonstrate and prove its financial capacity by other means/evidences, it may submit a bid including evidences about its financial capacity. The Evaluation Committee will consider this evidences/situation and will take a decision about accepting/rejecting such a bid.

This clarification does not constitute a promise/guarantee that such bid will be accepted.
