## SEC/RFP/19/2018 – Provision of satellite voice and data services and supply of satellite communications hardware equipment to the OSCE **Clarification Note 5**

The Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe has received requests for clarification from potential Proposers on Wed 03/10/2018 14:30 and Wed 03/10/2018 15:35 with regard to Request for Proposal SEC/RFP/19/2018. The OSCE would like to provide the following clarifications:

- Q1: "Please advise which satellite for Ka band is preferred for Europe and Central Asia as requested? Should it use 2 separate satellites due to narrow beam technology?"
- A1: We do not have any preferred Satellite for Ka band. For us it is Ok if two or more separate satellites are used to provide the service In Europe and Central Asia locations.
- Q2: "As it is requested 150Gb and 500Gb monthly data allowance per site, what Internet speed for down and up in Kbps is preferred on Ka band VSAT service per each 150 and 500Gb data allowance or should the speed be the same for both services as requested?"
- A2: In the case of 150/Gb the minimum speed required is 5 Mbps Down and 2 Mbps upload. For 500 Gb the speeds to be offered may be 10/4, 15/5 and 20/5.

Q3: "What kind of applications will be used on Ka band service on the top of Internet Access?"

- A3: All applications to be used will be web based.
- Q4: "Does Ka band service require dedicated bandwidth or shared bandwidth? What speed?"
- A4: There is no requirement for dedicated bandwidth. Shared bandwidth is sufficient.
- Q5: "How many sites are proposed in Central Asia?"
- A5: Number of sites in Central Asia may be 3-5 (Note: this figure is only for planning purposes, no contractual purposes as the service required is optional).
- Q6: "How many sites are proposed in Europe?"
- A6: Number of sites in Europe may be 3-8 (Note: this figure is only for planning purposes, no contractual purposes as the service required is optional).
- Q7: "Is it okay to offer the service on Comtech, iDirect or Viasat platforms with 1.2 m and 1.8 m antenna? Or, do you have any specific requirements to access Ka band service?"
- A7: As stated in the point 1 above we have not any preferred platform. 1.2m and 1.8 m antennas are OK.
