Clarification Note 1**

The Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe (“the OSCE”) has received requests for clarification from potential bidders with regard to RFP/06/2012.

In accordance with Article 8 “Clarification of Bidding Documents” of Instructions to Bidders - the OSCE would like to provide the following clarifications:

Question 1

Does the status of the OSCE as an entity translate into the requirement for a risk management company or private security company license in accordance with Presidential Decree 62?

Answer 1

We are currently seeking further clarification from the Afghan Authorities. In the meantime please proceed on the assumption that the OSCE is entitled to engage a Private Security Company or a Risk Management Company.

Are you looking for expatriate or LN Personal Protection Officers?
