Clarification Note No. 3

The OSCE received a request for clarification from potential bidder. In accordance with Article 8 “Clarification of Bidding Documents” of Section I of the Bidding Documents the OSCE would like to provide the following clarifications:

Question:

In Section IV – Technical Specifications and Schedule of Requirements, points 2.6, 2.9, 4.7 you require optional features, should we quote these optional features separately?

Answer:

The features described in 2.6 and 2.9 are optional and, if offered, shall be included in the price, i.e. not priced separately. The features indicated in 4.7 are mandatory.

Question:

Does the OSCE want a lesser accuracy of the odometer presented by GPS system or the OSCE wants a 100% accuracy achieved by a connection to the onboard computer of the vehicle, which is type/brand dependant and costs more?

Answer:

Equipment should have the possibility to connect to the onboard computer as a standard. Although the odometer reading is not achievable by GPS means, the system should have provide for a possibility to manually correct the discrepancies that should always be less than 2%/trip.
